Dear Lawrence:

I am forwarding as an enclosure some documents I have received from a constituent regarding the heroic actions of Lieutenant Colonel John Sorrells JAF retired, at Duc Phu airstrip in Vietnam in July, 1969. Please review these documents and provide me with the status of the award nomination that was referred to your department last month.

Lieutenant Colonel Sorrells was responsible for saving the lives of approximately 25 patients when a fire broke out on board the aircraft that was transporting them. By remaining on the burning aircraft and ensuring the safety of the patients, Sorrells displayed courage worthy of recognition. The awards citations written up at that time were apparently never processed due to the stresses of combat.

Last summer, this matter was referred to the office of President Clinton. The attached correspondence indicates that it was subsequently referred to your office by the National Personnel Records Center on April 16, 2001. In light of the many years that have passed since Lieutenant Colonel Sorrells' heroic action, I ask that you expedite your review of this case to ensure he receives appropriate recognition as soon as possible.
