Dear Mr. Billman,

Pursuant to information received from the Federal Elections Commission, by letter dated January 21, 1998, the American Iron and Steel Institute hereby requests a refund of campaign contributions in excess of \$1000 due to our non-multicandidate status. As you are aware, such status limits the dollar amount that may be contributed to any one election campaign for a particular candidate to no more than \$1000.

FEC filings indicate that a total of \$2000 was donated to Citizens for Arlen Specter as campaign contributions, \$1000 on June 30, 1995, and \$1000 on June 5, 1997. Each contribution was designated for disbursement to Senator Specter's primary election. This was, of course, a matter of oversight and we apologize for any inconvenience it has caused you.

AISI thanks you in advance for your prompt attention to this matter.
