In response to your letters requesting additional information regarding both reporting periods, I would like to respond as follows to each inquiry.

Mid-Year Report (1/1/03-6/30/03)

The Commission inquires as to what, if any, expenses we had for administrative expenses relating to ARPAC. As per 2 U.S.C. Section 441a and 441b, ARPAC wishes to amend its report and verify that all activity associated with ARPAC was volunteer in nature and were done by volunteer's on their time. This amendment will also apply to each report within the two-year election cycle- all volunteer activity.

Year-End Report (7/1/03-12/31/03)

Two specific issues were addressed in the letter from the Commission dated May 6, 2005. One issue was a discrepancy in ending balance and beginning balance on the mid-year and end of year 2003 reports. That issue was addressed and all additional reports were amended to reflect the correction and proper reporting balance. (All amendments were electronically filed, accepted, and posted on the FEC website May 10, 2005.

The second and final issue the Commission requested clarification on was the official address of the ARPAC. As was discussed with Will Wiquist on May 10, 2005.
