Dear Mr. Corcoran:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses contributions to various apparent "leadership" political action committees; however, you have disclosed the names of various federal candidates in the candidate name field. The inverse has also been reported (see chart below). Please clarify whether these were earmarked contributions made by your committee through these committees to these candidates, or if you made these contributions to the political committees exercising no direction or control over how the funds were to be used. If the latter is the case, please only include the name of the apparent leadership PAC(s) on Schedule B. Please amend your report to clarify the ultimate recipient of these contributions.

-Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to the authorized United States House of Representatives campaign committee for "The Richard Burr Committee"; however, this committee is terminated and this candidate is running for the United States Senate in the 2004 Election. Please clarify to what committee this contribution was given.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated.

Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
