

For Reporting Period 03/01/2009-03/31/2009:

1. Schedule A supporting Line 12 disclosed a transfer(s) - in from Republican National Committee. The aforementioned transfer was not used for any FEA activity. The "FEA - exempt mass mail" disbursements characterized as exempt activities meet the conditions for campaign materials as they were conducted on behalf of the party's nominees in the general election, the materials were distributed by volunteers - not through public political advertising, we did not use materials purchased by the national party committee or money transferred from the national committee to purchase materials, no earmarked funds were used are were made with 100% federal funds.
2. The MEMO entries disclosed on Schedule B supporting Line 22 have been removed, as they should not have been on the report. The entries consisted of transfers between two of the NY State Committee's federal bank accounts and were made for accounting purposes only. The entries did not affect our balance as they were not disbursements or receipts and did not involve any other party committee, candidate, or vendor.
3. The "FEA - exempt mass mail" disbursements characterized as exempt activities meet the conditions for campaign materials as they were conducted on behalf of the party's nominees in the general election, the materials were distributed by volunteers - not through public political advertising, we did not use materials purchased by the national party committee or money transferred from the national committee to purchase materials, no earmarked funds were used are were made with 100% federal funds.
4. Schedule B supporting Line 30 (b) discloses payments for "FEA - exempt mass mail" which are properly categorized as FEA and meets the conditions for exempt activity. The federal candidate associated with these disbursements is James Tedisco (H0NY00048).
5. The H4 disbursement disclosed as direct candidate support was miscategorized. The disbursement was an administrative expense for a magazine subscription (see amended report).
8. Our February, March, and April Monthly reports disclose all administrative expenses associated with operating a political committee. The New York Republican Party currently does not have any rent or mortgage expenses as the Party owns the building in which it is headquartered and conducts all of its operations (deed filed 10/30/1991).
