Dear Mr. Walker:

This letter is submitted in response to your request for additional information regarding the July Quarterly 2000 report and certain contributions made by QPAC, which we received on November 22, 2000. Your letter indicated that two candidates, Rep. Billy Tauzin and Rep. John Dingell, may have received excessive contributions from QPAC.

In the case of Congressman Tauzin, QPAC has made a good faith effort to obtain a refund of \$1000 for the contribution made on September 29, 1999. On August 7, 2000, QPAC called and sent a letter to Rep. Tauzin's principal campaign committee requesting a refund. A copy of that letter was submitted to the FEC and has since become part of the public record. Upon receiving your November 22, 2000 correspondence, QPAC has telephoned the committee again and sent a second request for a refund. That letter is attached.

The second issue relates to a contribution made to Congressman Dingell on June 6, 2000. To remedy what would otherwise be considered an excessive contribution, we have requested a refund in the amount of \$1,000. That letter is also attached. We will promptly report the refund on our FEC reports as soon as the check is received from Congressman Dingell's committee.


Dear Ms. Clement:




Re: Qualcomm PAC Contribution

During the review and filing of our most recent Federal Election Commission report, we discovered an inadvertent oversight related to the contribution Qualcomm's PAC made to Rep. Dingell on June 6, 2000. Unfortunately, that contribution was in excess of the \$1,000 general election limit that applies to PACs that have not yet reached multi-candidate status. Because QPAC did not reach multi-candidate status until July, 2000, we must request a refund of \$1000 so that our contributions to Congressman Dingell remain within the legal limit.
