This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses one or more receipts totaling \$13,218.90 from "CDW-G", "Campbell & Campbell Campaigns, Inc.", and "United Fin. Cas. Co.". Please amend your report to clarify the nature of these receipts.

-Schedule B supporting Line 30(b) of your report discloses a payment(s) for "FEA Event Photographer", "FEA Mail Production", "FEA Phone Bank", "FEA Postage", and "FEA Rally Phone Calls" which is categorized as Federal Election Activity and therefore, may require the disclosure of the candidate(s) this activity should be attributed to. Expenditures and disbursements for public communications that refer to a clearly identified candidate for Federal office and that promote, support, attack or oppose any candidate for Federal office, meet the definition of Federal Election Activity under 11 CFR §100.24 and should be disclosed on Schedule B for Line 30(b) along with the identity of the candidate(s).

Further, please be advised that public communications that meet the definition of Federal Election Activity and that also contain express advocacy as defined under 11 CFR §100.22, but do not meet the conditions

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
