Dear Mr. Parker:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule B supporting Line 28(a) of your report discloses a negative entry for an apparent refund of a contribution received during a previous reporting period. Please be advised that refunds should be disclosed as positive disbursements on Schedule B. This method of reporting would clarify for the public record the total amount of the disbursement and more accurately disclose the cash-on-hand amount. Please amend your report to properly disclose this activity or provide clarifying information.

-Your report discloses an outstanding balance(s) beginning this period for a debt(s) owed to Florida Power & Light Company and Visa. However, an outstanding balance(s) at the close of the period was not disclosed on your August Monthly Report (7/1/05-7/31/05). Please amend your report(s) to clarify this discrepancy.

-The outstanding balance of a debt owed to a creditor at the close of one report should be exactly the same as the outstanding balance beginning the period of the next report. This report shows a beginning outstanding

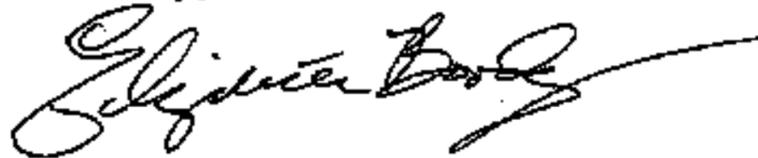
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balance(s) to Lanier Worldwide, Inc., which is not identical to the ending outstanding balance(s) for the creditor(s) on the August Monthly Report (7/1/05-7/31/05). Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
