On 5/1/2014 the FEC issued us an RFAI in reference to our December Monthly Report. We were asked to address four issues:

1. Receipts on Schedule A supporting line 11c from unregistered committees DBA Citizens for Peter Barca, Shawano County Democratic Party, Washington County Democratic Party, Winnebago County Democratic Party, Wood County Democratic Party, Citizens for Zepnick, Forward with JoCasta, Friends of Chris Taylor, Friends of Dianne Hesselbein, Friends of Gary Hebl, Friends of LaTonya Johnson, Friends of Melissa Sargent, Friends of Rob Kahl, Friends of Sandy Pasch, Friends of Sody Pope-Roberts, Friends of Terese Berceau, Goyke for Assembly, Hintz for Assembly, Smith for 75th, and Wachs for Assembly have been deemed permissible. These contributions were made by non-Federal candidates and local committees that had the required funds from Federally-permissible sources. The funds were verified to have come from permissible sources and no amount exceeded the \$1,000 threshold that would require the committees to register with the Commission.
2. Upon further investigation propted by the RFAI, and review of the NEA contribution - there was no indication on it the check that the contribution was from their state PAC. To remedy the situation we will refund the contribution in June and report it in the Julyl monthly.
3. Transfers in 2013 from the Obama Victory Fund 2012, Tammy Baldwin Victory Fund and Swing State Victory Fund are all from contributions raised during the 2012 election cycle. Accordingly there are no additional memoed contributions to report, as they were reported in the December 2012 report.
4. Contributions memoed from ""WI Party Victory Fund"" are from the ""DSP Joint Victory Fund."" When the DNC sends us the memoes they put in the state name instead of the generic term. Corresponding receipts include \$12,952.13 on 1/8, \$11,807.79 on 4/26, \$17,631.71 on 7/11 and \$20,570.75 on 10/14.
