On behalf of the American Society of Pension Professionals & Actuaries PAC, I recently uploaded to the FEC an amendment to our December 2005 monthly report. The amended report was in response to your letter of April 26, 2006.

In the original December 2005 report, I mistakenly reported inadvertent contributions (deposits to ASPPA PAC) and reported them on the incorrect line. The errors occurred because ASPPA PAC's new online contribution system was initially set up incorrectly. In November, four ASPPA members(1) paid their membership dues online and their dues were inadvertently deposited into ASPPA PAC's account instead of ASPPA's general account.

The software error to PAC's online contribution system was corrected as soon as it was discovered. The dues were redirected to ASPPA in December and the subsequent re-flow of funds was reflected in our January 2006 Year-end report. The four members, all members of ASPPA PAC's eligible class, had no knowledge of the error; all funds were permissible. All transactions were electronic.

There are no changes to the Detailed Summary page for said report; all contribution amounts are correct.

I apologize for the error.
