This submission responds to the Commission's letter of February 25, 2005 regarding the committee's Post-General Report:

- 1) The committee acknowledges that it was tardy in making the transfer for the federal portion of the in-kind. This oversight was completely inadvertent and was caused by the fact that a consultant working on a television advertisement did not immediately notify the committee that it was using a song whose rights had been donated to the committee. The committee made the transfer as soon as it learned of this fact.
- 2) The transfer of \$5,320 was made due to the fact that certain contributions made to the federal account, while legal under federal rules, were intended to be deposited into the committee's non-federal account for use in connection with non-federal elections.
- 3) The committee has transferred \$637 on March 17, 2005 to return the non-federal portion of the expense to the committee's non-federal account.
- 5) Please note that all payments for office supplies were for ordinary supplies such as paper, pens, clipboards. It was customary for volunteers of the organization to obtain their own supplies and then be reimbursed by the committee.
- 6) Missing addresses are included.
- 7) All expenses for 'advertising,' 'photography,' 'printing,' 'space rental,' 'ad production,' 'print advertising,' 'print design,' 'signs,' 'television ad production,' 'tv ad production,' and 'tv production' were not on behalf of any federal candidate.
