On December 18, 2002, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your January 6, 2003 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of your report discloses a receipt(s) from VARIOUS. Please be advised that federal regulations require the itemization of all contributions from individuals/persons that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. The Commission is in receipt of your response in which you state that the funds were obtained from passing a hat around the room and each person being instructed not to put in more than \$5. Please note that while this explains one of your disclosures, your report discloses several additional entries from 'VARIOUS.' Please clarify whether these figures include any receipts that aggregate greater than \$200 from an individual/person. If this is the case, please amend your report by itemizing the receipts on Schedule A. 11 CFR 104.3 (a)(2)

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by January 29, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by

this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
