I am in receipt of your letter dated March 3, 1999 regarding the NSSTA PAC's 30 day Post-General Report. In your letter you state that in our report we listed a contribution to a candidate in excess of allowable contribution limits. I recognized this error in December 1998 and asked Pete Stark's Re-Election Committee to redesignate the contribution to the 2000 primary election. I have enclosed a copy of the letter to Mr. Stark. Unfortunately, I failed to indicate the redesignation by memo entry in our PAC's last filing with the FEC. I apologize for this omission.
