Dear Mr. Sosa:

On May 24, 2000, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your June 13, 2000, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The amended Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses the apparent redesignation of your March 28, 2000 contribution to the Bill Thomas Campaign Committee from the General to the Primary Election; however, the funds were disbursed after the election date of March 7, 2000.

Please note that contributions may not be designated for an election which has already occurred unless the funds are to be used to reduce a candidate committee's debts incurred during that election campaign. Campaign finance reports filed by the Bill Thomas Campaign Committee to the Commission indicate that the committee did not have any debt arising from the expenses of the primary election.


Please provide clarification regarding any corrective action taken with regards to this contribution, and disclose any redesignations or refunds as necessary on the appropriate schedules. You may also submit a copy of the

letter redesignating the contribution in question or a copy of the refund request in response to this letter.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by July 5, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
