On behalf of the American Society of Pension Professionals & Actuaries PAC, I recently uploaded to the FEC an amendment to our January 2006 Year-end report. The amended report was in response to your letter of April 26, 2006.

In our original January 2006 report, I mistakenly reported the refund of November 2005 inadvertent contributions and reported them on the incorrect line. The inadvertent contributions occurred due to ASPPA PAC's new online contribution system being set up incorrectly. ASPPA membership dues for four members(1) were inadvertently deposited into ASPPA PAC's account (see December 2005 report to the FEC). The software error to PAC's online contribution system was corrected as soon as it was discovered. The dues were redirected to ASPPA's general account in December and the subsequent re-flow of funds was reflected in our January 2006 Year-end report. The four members are all members of ASPPA PAC's eligible class; they had no knowledge of the error; all funds were permissible. All transactions were electronic.

There are no changes to the Detailed Summary page for said report; all disbursement amounts are correct.
