This statement is in response to the Commission's letter dated March 7, 2013. The Commission requested additional information on five items.

- 1.The Commission requested clarifying information regarding voids of contributions received from "MRS. MARY JO KOVACEVICH" and "MR. RICHARD M. KOVACEVICH." These contributions were previously reported on our Committee's September Monthly report. Please refer to FEC filing ID: FEC-842781, Page 184 of 297, Items B & C and Page 185 of 297, Items A & B on.
- 2.The Commission requested clarifying information regarding the aggregate year-to-date totals of several contributors that is greater than the total receipts disclosed from these individuals. The aggregate year to date totals reflected on our Committee's report filed 12/19/2012 were disclosed in error. Our Committee has amended our report to reflect the correct aggregate totals.
- 3.The Commission stated that Schedule B of our report discloses in-kind contributions that were not itemized on Schedule A. Our Committee has amended our report to itemize these in-kind contributions on Schedule A. These in-kind contributions were previously included on Line 11 but not itemized on Schedule A. There is no effect on the cash on hand amount.
- 4.The Committee has reviewed all reimbursements to individuals for travel and subsistence and confirms that no further itemization is required under any Commission regulations for these expenditures.
- 5.The Commission requested disclosure of the identity of candidates supported or opposed by Federal Election Activity disclosed by our report. Identities of candidates where applicable have been disclosed on our amended report.

This should answer the Commission's inquiry.
