Dear Ms. Parks:

In response to your letter dated January 15, 2003 to the Wyeth Good Government Fund, enclosed is a copy of the Contributor Redesignation Form from John D. Dingell for Congress Committee indicating that the \$5,000 contribution made on October 29, 2002 was redesignated to the 2004 primary campaign on December 6, 2002. Apparently this redesignation was not properly filed with the FEC.

The second issue in your letter addresses an in-kind contribution to the Citizens for Arlen Specter designated to the 2004 Primary Election. As Senator Specter is not up for re-election until 2004, your request to apply the contribution to the 2002 General Election is incorrect. Per your telephone conversation on January 23, 2003 with Tanya Caspers of Democracy Data and Communications, you will notify the Compliance Branch of the Reports Analysis Division that this contribution was reported correctly in the original 30-Day Post General report filed on December 2, 2002 and that a response by the Wyeth GGF is unnecessary.
