NACPAC's treasurer has authorized its chairman to receive contributions and make expenditures as set forth in 11 CFR §102.9. The chairman of NACPAC fulfills all recordkeeping duties as set forth in 11 CFR §102.9 (a) through (d). NACPAC's chairman maintains all committee books and records,
