
Dear Sirs:

Your letter referenced above indicated the existence of an excessive contribution for the 1996 election from the PMA PAC to the Robert Torricelli for U.S. Senate campaign. I have reviewed our records and concur with your assessment.

The Torricelli campaign staff has been requested to re-designate the PMA PAC May 14, 1997 contribution from "1996 debt retirement" to the "2002 primary election". Enclosed is a copy of the letter requesting the re-designation. I believe this action should cure the excessive contribution problem. The PMA PAC April 1998 Quarterly Report will reflect a memo entry to document the re-designation.

I regret the error and I am confident that a similar error will not occur in the future. I appreciate the assistance and courtesy of the FEC staff in helping identify a suitable solution.

The Federal Election Commission has recently notified PMA PAC of an excessive contribution to the Robert Torricelli for U.S. Senate campaign. This was created by a \$1,000 April 23, 1996 contribution for the 1996 general election followed by a May 14, 1997 \$1,000 contribution to the Senator's 1996 general campaign debt retirement. As a non-multicandidate political committee, PMA PAC is limited to contributing \$1,000 per election.

Confirming our discussion of last week, PMA PAC would like to re-designate the May 14, 1997 debt retirement contribution to instead support the Senator's 2002 primary campaign. This will correct the 1996 general election excessive contribution.

Thank you for your cooperation in correcting this error.
