The Conservative Reform Agenda in Government (CRAIG PAC, FEC ID# C00409326) is in receipt of your letter dated September 21, 2005 concerning our 2005 mid-year FEC report.

With respect to the matters referenced in your letter, the disbursements for fundraising consulting and travel expenses, fundraising consulting, website registration, fundraising consulting/delivery expense, travel/postage, fundraising consulting/printing, accounting services/postage, and printing were all for the operating expenses of the Committee. None of these disbursements were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates.

They are not expenses for public communications, voter drive activity, or express advocacy, and thus do not constitute in-kind or coordinated expenditures. Accordingly, no schedules for Lines 23 or 24 are required, and no amendments are necessary concerning these disbursements.

Please be aware that the Committee continues to incur many administrative and operating expenses of a similar nature. Please let us know if there is a suggested method of disclosure that will more clearly identify them as operating and administrative expenses, and not disbursements that would fall under any of the categories of candidate involvement listed in your letter.

In addition, all administrative and operating expenses of the Committee, including these expenses referenced in your letter, have been fully disclosed, and no other goods or services have been provided to the Committee. Therefore, no amendment to this report is necessary.
