-Your report discloses a payment(s) on Schedule D to Economy Office Products, which has not been recorded on a disbursement schedule. Debt payments must be reflected on Schedules H4 or B as well as on Schedule D. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(5)(D)

-Please clarify all expenditures made for Telemarketing on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B or F supporting Lines 23 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
