Dear Mr. Whyrick:

We are in receipt of your letter dated June 2, 2014. Our understanding is that our April quarterly report did not include all of the required information of some contributors.

We have filed an amended April quarterly report to include additional information we have obtained from contributors. We have and continue to exercise our best efforts to obtain missing information. Our best efforts process includes the following procedures.

Our original solicitations include a clear and conspicuous request for the contributor's information and inform the contributor of federal law for the reporting of such information. Please see the attached Exhibit 1.

If the information is not provided, we make at least one follow up effort to obtain the information. The follow up letter is sent no later than 30 days after receipt of the contribution. The letter asks for the missing information without soliciting a contribution, informs the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information, and includes a pre-addressed envelope. Please see the attached Exhibit 2.

Finally, if the missing contributor information is received, we disclose it via a memo on a subsequent report or amend the original report to include the information. In this case, we have filed an amended report to include information received through our best efforts procedures. This report is available for viewing on the FEC's website.

Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Commission Regulations require that a committee discloses the identification of all individuals who contribute in excess of \$200 in an election cycle. (11 CFR § 104.3(a)(4)(i)) Identification for an individual is defined as the full name (initials for first or last name are not acceptable), **complete mailing address**, occupation, and name of employer. (11 CFR § 100.12) Your report discloses contributions from individuals for which the identification is not complete.

The following employer and occupation entries appear on your report and are not considered acceptable: "REQUESTED/Attorney", "REQUESTED/REQUESTED."

You must provide the missing information, or if you are unable to do so, you must demonstrate that "best efforts" have been used to obtain the information. To establish "best efforts," you must provide the Commission with a detailed description of your procedures for requesting the information. Establishing "best efforts" is a three-fold process.

First, your original solicitation must include a clear and conspicuous request for the contributor information and must inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information. (11 CFR § 104.7(b)(1)) See 11 CFR § 104.7(b)(1)(B) for examples of acceptable statements regarding

Federal law requires Claitor for Congress to obtain and report the name, mailing address, occupation and employer of persons whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$500 in one election cycle.
