Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Senate Public Records Office by the response date noted above. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

- Schedule A supporting line 12 discloses a transfer from the joint fundraising committee, Wyden for Oregon, in the amount of \$6,150.00. You must provide a Memorandum Schedule A disclosing your share of gross receipts. Contributions from original contributors whose total contributions to your committee have exceeded \$200 during the election cycle must be itemized on this schedule. Please note that the sum of memo Schedules A supporting a transfer from a joint fundraising committee should be greater than or equal to the amount reported on Line 12. Each participating committee shall report its share of **net** proceeds received from the joint fundraising committee as a transfer-in on Line 12. Each participating committee shall also file memo Schedules A itemizing its share of the **gross** receipts as contributions from the original donors. (11 CFR § 102.17(c)(8)(i)(B)) Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee

will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
