Dear FEC

I am Robert Leon Tillman, the former candidate for Congress in 2012. I am also the Robert Tillman for Congress' Treasurer in the 2012 campaign. I was notified by the FEC of the requirement to file form 99 (or form 499) and I attempted to do that on 1-14-13, however, the FEC reported to me on 8-29-13 that the form was not received. The FEC said on 8-29-13 that I could file this letter instead; to explain (1) \$6,600.00 starting cash on hand, (2) Item # 8 & 9 regarding \$14,221.12 to Southwest National Bank on my termination report, (3) \$14, 221.12 campaign balance per the FEC, line # 15 & 21 for \$12,923.00 should be on schedule B not schedule A, and (4) \$25,000.00 loan from candidate to Committee. This letter will serve as an Amendment to my filed FEC termination Report dated 12-3-12.

1. My campaign for Congress started with three loans, one in the amount of \$2,000 @ no interest from my spouse Linda Tillman who paid for the campaign filing fee plus other expenses. The Campaign Committee failed to raise enough funds to repay this loan and Linda Tillman converted this \$2,000 loan to a donation at the conclusion of the campaign. My Campaign Committee accepted a loan of \$2,600 @ no interest from my brother Hurigh Tillman, Sr for campaign expenses at the start of the campaign. The Campaign Committee failed to raise enough funds to repay the loan and Hurigh Tillman Sr converted \$2,500 of the \$2,600 to a donation at the conclusion of the campaign. The Committee repaid \$100 of the \$2,600 loan and accepted the \$2,500 as a donation. MR. Hurigh Tillman Sr died on 4-30-13. My Campaign

Committee also accepted a loan \$2,000 @ no interest from S. Jean Craig, Ph.D for campaign expenses at the start of the campaign. The Campaign Committee failed to raise enough funds to repay this loan and Dr. Craig converted this loan to a \$2,000 to a donation at the conclusion of the campaign. The total of \$6,600 listed on 4-1-12 quarterly report was spent as campaign expenses and none of these funds remained at the close of the campaign on 12-3-12.

2. My campaign Committee made payments of \$14,221.12 to Southwest National Bank for the use of a 2005 Chevrolet Corvette which was used daily during the campaign. The FEC stated that this loan should have been listed on Schedule B. The FEC stated that this \$14,221.12 appeared as an ending campaign bank balance on my termination report. This money was never in the campaign bank account and is not a campaign balance.
3. The FEC stated that \$14,221.12 is listed as campaign balance, however the facts are that Robert Tillman made individual monthly payments of \$680.?? at 18. % for a total of \$14,221.12 to Southwest National Bank from Robert Tillman's personal funds. This \$14,221.12 was a campaign transportation expense. The FEC stated that this loan payment should have been listed on Schedule B.
4. I; Robert Tillman gave my Campaign Committee a line of credit up to \$25,000 to pay for the Robert Tillman for Congress Campaign expenses until the campaign could get campaign donations. The Campaign Committee failed to raise enough funds to replace this line of credit. This line of credit was used by the campaign committee to pay all expenses of the campaign as they occurred. Most of the operational campaign expense incurred was paid for from this line of credit by the candidate Robert Tillman from his personal funds. The termination report listed \$12,923.00 on line 17 should have been listed on Schedule B not on Schedule A as an operational expense per the FEC.

The close of my Robert Leon Tillman for Congress Campaign ended with no outstanding loans and no cash in the campaign bank account. The loan creditors made no attempts to collect their debts. No debt settlement plan was necessary for the creditors or me. If there were any moneys left from the campaign line of credit, it should be returned to the candidate; Robert Leon Tillman for a refund of the campaign operation expenses. The Termination Report correctly lists the amount of the campaign donations received by the Campaign Committee. The report was accepted as received by the FEC system on 12-3-12 and was assigned the Filing ID of FEC 836160. I hereby offer this Amendment to that report to explain errors in the report. I request that the FEC review this amendment letter to my Robert Leon Tillman for Congress Campaign termination report as having no outstanding debts or obligations and close the campaign quarterly reporting requirements.


