Donations for each are from the same persons. (Members of the Tennessee Road Builders Association). Donations to the Tennessee Highway Contractors Political Action Committee are subject to the same restrictions as to the Tennessee Road Builders Association Political Action Committee, except; all donations over \$100 must report by name and address of individual. The separation of the two (2) political action committees are for reporting purposes only.

The July Quarterly Report shows a transfer of \$2500 from the Tennessee Highway Contractors Political Action Committee to the Tennessee Road Builders Association Political Action Committee on attached summary pages 11. a, ii. as unitemized. (See copy attached.)


