This letter responds to Ms. Laura E. Sinram's letter dated February 27, 2008 regarding the Legacy Committee Political Action Committee. This office represents the Legacy Committee and it follows our telephone conversation on March 13, 2008. In response to your letter please receive the following information.

With respect to your first question regarding reporting of mailings containing express advocacy please note the following. The Legacy PAC did prepare five discreet mailings during the reporting period. Upon review we determined three of the five did include express advocacy. On March 25, 2008 I met with the treasurer of the committee to review the appropriate method of reporting. Please note, the treasurer will file an amended report consistant with your letter by April 15, 2008.

In addition, we have determined we will need to amend the year end report for the calendar year 2007 to be consistant with the guidance of your letter which will be amended and filed by May 15, 2008.

With respect to your second question please be advised Legacy PAC had no administrative expenses that were reportable during the reporting period. Please note that the Legacy PAC retains no permanent office, phone service, and posses no office equipment and does not pay utilities.
