



Dear Madam:

In compliance with Federal Election Commission (FEC) regulations, and for the reasons set for the below, the Holland & Knight Committee for Effective Government (H&KCEG) hereby requests a redesignation of the contributions dated July 11, 2000 and July 18, 2000.

The 2000 primary election your candidate faced was held in California on April 4, 2000. The H&KCEG contribution to your Committee, although it was designated for the 2000 primary election, was made after that election, on July 11, 2000 and July 18, 2000. As you know, a political committee may not make a contribution to a Federal candidate's campaign's net debts outstanding from such election. To avoid the complexity inherent in inquiring into your primary campaign debt status as of the date of our contribution, the H&KCEG is, as stated above, simply redesignating its contributions as contributions for the 2000 general election.
