If this figure includes any receipts from a single source, that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year, please amend your report(s) by itemizing the receipts on Schedule A. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2)(J)

-Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to Rhode Island Coordinated Campaign. Please clarify whether this is a federal committee(s), as there does not appear to be a committee(s) registered with the Commission under this name(s). In the event this is a non-federal committee(s), please disclose it on Schedule B supporting Line 29 of the Detailed Summary Page.

-Your report includes computer produced formats of what appears to be a

Schedule A. Computer produced formats may only be used upon prior approval of the Commission. You should submit a separate sample format with a cover letter requesting approval. Until your format has been approved, FEC forms must be used. 11 CFR §104.2(d)
