Dear Ms. Jones:

Per your conversation with the Committee's CPA, Amy C. Gilbert, I write regarding the four expenditures referenced in your letter of October 21, 2005. In three of these instances, the Committee initially disclosed media production expenses on 24-hour reports in connection with independent expenditure advertisements, and later received additional information from the vendor identifying additional costs. Please refer to 24-hour reports filed on 10/26/04 dates for media production expenses incurred with Greer Margolis Mitchell Burns as follows: Carson-Coburn \$61,097.56; Mongiardo-Bunning \$25,000.00; and Vitter \$38,752.99. In the fourth instance, the Committee filed a 24-hour report for independent expenditure advertisements, and later received information from the vendor regarding the production costs. Please refer to the 24-hour report filed on 10/28/04 for media buy expenses incurred with Great American Media as follows: Daschle-Thune \$750,571.31.




