RE: Response to RFAI on Amended 30 day Post-General Report (filed 1/31/2011)
League of Conservation Voters Action Fund: C00252940 (LCVAF)

Dear Ms. Della Rocco:

Responses to the inquiries in your letter of March 29, 2011 follow.

1. The October 14, 2010 independent expenditure payment of \$58.47 for automated calls on behalf of Martin Heinrich was below the \$1,000 threshold for 24 hour independent expenditure notices, and thus did not trigger an obligation to file such a notice. LCVAF did file a notice of independent expenditures on behalf of Martin Heinrich on October 30, 2010. The \$58.47 expenditure was mistakenly excluded from the aggregate total on the October 30 notice due to an administrative oversight. We apologize for the oversight, but would like to emphasize that LCVAF did not fail to file a required 24 hour notice, but rather simply omitted a small sum from the aggregate total on the timely notice LCVAF did file.

2. The October 28, 2010 independent expenditures supporting Brian Lentz, Patrick Murphy, and Joseph Sestak were paid for by the League of Conservation Voters, Inc. (LCV), LCVAF's connected organization, rather than by LCVAF. Thus, the 24 hour notice for an independent expenditure you cite should have been filed by LCV, rather than LCVAF. These expenditures were accurately reported by LCV on its 2010 Year End Form 5 (pages 2047-2048) available at: <http://query.nictusa.com/pdf/586/11930318586/11930318586.pdf#navpanes=0>, and LCVAF's amended 12 day Post-General Report accurately does not include these independent expenditures. The 24 hour notice (which cannot be amended) was timely filed, but incorrectly attributed the expenditure to an affiliated entity.

3. In terms of incomplete contributor and/or employer information, LCVAF would first note that it disclosed complete information for approximately 99 percent of the itemized 4,444 contributions included on the Post-General Report. Due to an administrative error, 12 of the itemized contributions did not include complete employer and occupation information that LCVAF was in possession of at the time of filing the original report. We will amend our Post-General Report to include this data, thus bringing LCVAF's complete information percentage to approximately 100 percent.
