Dear Mr. Nagel:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-You have failed to designate BancFirst and First American Bank as depositories on your Statement of Organization (FEC FORM 1). Commission Regulations require that each political committee disclose the name of its campaign depository or depositories (State banks, Federally chartered depository institutions or depository institutions the depositor accounts of which are insured). Please amend (electronically) your Statement of Organization to disclose all committee depositories. (11 CFR § 102.2(a)(1)(vi))

-On Schedule B of your report, you have disclosed contributions to a federal candidate, political party committee or other political committee. Commission regulations require that these itemized disbursements include the recipient's full name, complete address, date, amount, purpose, state, office sought (House, Senate, or President), and district (if applicable). Please amend your report to include the state, office sought and district (if applicable). (11 CFR §§104.3 (b)(4) and 104.9(b))

-For future reports, please be advised that contributions from Native American Tribes must be reported on Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page and itemized on an accompanying Schedule A. Line 11(c) should only be used to report contributions from other political committees. (2 U.S.C. §434)
