The International Union of Operating Engineers/Engineers Political Education Committee (IUOE/EPEC) recently discovered that we had inadvertently attributed a 2008 primary election contribution to the wrong campaign committee. This occurred when a March 13, 2007 contribution of \$2,500 to the 2008 primary election of [Allyson] Schwartz for Congress (FEC ID #C00389197) was inadvertently entered into our Vocus software program, which records our PAC contributions, as a 2008 primary contribution to [John] Schwarz for Congress (FEC ID #C00395822). Consequently, this resulted in an affiliated IUOE federal PAC (IUOE Operating Engineers, FEC ID #C00136739) making an excessive contribution to the primary election campaign of [Allyson] Schwartz for Congress on April 13, 2008.

Please find enclosed a letter from our affiliated federal PAC, IUOE Operating Engineers, to Schwartz for Congress requesting a refund in the amount of \$1,500 for the April 14, 2008 contribution made to her 2008 primary campaign.

IUOE/EPEC has amended its FEC April 2007 Monthly Report to reflect these corrections.
