RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This is in response to the Commission's preliminary review of VIGOP's March 20th FEC Disclosure Report that raised questions regarding the following items:

TRANSFER TO TERRITORIAL ACCOUNT

A transfer to VIGOP's State (Territorial) Account was made in the amount of \$2,299.68 from its Federal Account on 2/27/2014. These funds when disbursed will be used for local (Territorial) election activities and/or administrative expenses and will be reported to the Virgin Islands Board of Elections.

EXCESSIVE, PROHIBITED OR IMPERMISSIBLE CONTRIBUTIONS

The Commission's review identified a contribution to Tim Scott for Senate in the amount of \$3,500. Whereas the committee does not yet qualify as a Multi-Candidate Committee, the contribution should not have exceeded \$2,600. The Committee expects to receive a \$900 refund in the near future.

EXPENDITURE DESCRIPTIONS

The Committee has used the following descriptions for the Purpose of Disbursement: 'DIRECT MAIL - CREATIVE'; 'DIRECT MAIL - POSTAGE'; 'DIRECT MAIL - LIST RENTALS' and 'DIRECT MAIL - PRINTING & MAILSHOP'; to describe payments related to its direct mail fundraising activities. These fundraising efforts are for the benefit of VIGOP and no other committee (Federal or otherwise). These solicitation expenditures do not represent voter drive activity or public communications as defined by 11 CFR 100.26; or contain express advocacy as defined under 11 CFR 100.22.
