Dear Mr. Evans:

This letter is in response to your recent request for additional information concerning the above referenced report.

Peace Political Action Committee (PPAC) is a small organization with one employee that shares office space with its affiliate political committee, Council for a Livable World (FEC Id# C00029165), and other small programs. PPAC periodically pays its share of the facility and operating costs; but the costs are not large. Office utilities are included in the rent.

Disbursements for salary, payroll taxes and employee benefits (health insurance) are reported on all reports. On the mid-year report an in-kind contribution/transfer from Council for a Livable World was reported for rent, telephone and office supply expenses on Schedule A, Line 12, and Schedule B, Line 21b. A disbursement for rent on 8/20/99 was reported on Schedule B, Line 21b, on the year-end report. PPAC will pay its share of the rent for 2000 at an appropriate time during the year. Periodic payments for telephone and other office expenses are reported.

PPAC is not a separate segregated fund and has no "connected organization" as defined by 11 C.F.R. §100.6.
