Your September 26, 2002, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-A review of the reports filed by your committee (pertinent portion(s) attached) indicates that your committee received one or more transfers from Unity 1998 Committee which has not been disclosed on their report(s) of receipts and disbursements. Please provide further clarifying information regarding the source of the transfer(s) received by your committee.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by October 23, 2002. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather

than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
