Dear: Federal Election Committee,

In response and as a member and candidate as well as the concomitant requirements of outlines regarding a Statement of Organization of our ?Freedom Committee? I affirm this disclosure.

This opportunity does not designate a non-funding consensus unless of course for the pretense of promotions for air time or other documents of promotional value. This opportunity instead presents the pretense of purported funding upon financial backing and fundraising.

As the treasurer of this Freedom Committee it is also my understanding Form II is the designated form of which to state financial fundraising and all monies allocated to said objective. It is also my understanding until I have acquired more than \$49, 999.99 I do not have to report or disclose any financial monies to anyone. I would of course should someone ask to discuss these potential elements of funding be more than happy too.

?A political committee is considered to have reason to expect it will exceed the electronic filing threshold for the next two calendar years after the calendar year in which it exceeds \$50,000 in contributions or expenditures. Exception: This does not apply to an authorized committee with \$50,000 or less in net debts outstanding on January 1 of the year following the general election that anticipates terminating prior to January 1 of the next election year, as long as the candidate has not qualified under 2 U.S.C. ?432 as a candidate in the next election and does not intend to become a federal candidate in the next election. A new committee with no previous contributions or expenditures is considered to have reason to expect it will exceed the electronic filing threshold if it exceeds \$12,500 in contributions or expenditures during the first calendar quarter of the calendar year, or \$25,000 in contributions or expenditures in the first half of the calendar year.?

This Freedom Committee has sent the required documents necessary for a Statement of Organization and I have met the aforementioned requirements. As Treasurer of this Freedom Committee I do attest the following of page 10 of Congressional Candidates and Committees August 2011 guide, Line 9, Congressional Candidates and Committees August 2011

Campaign Depository A committee must list the name and address (but not the account number) of the campaign depositories

it maintains for depositing receipts and making disbursements. 102.2(a)(1)(vi). Each political committee shall maintain at least one checking account or transaction account at one of its depositories. 103.2. (One depository is required.) All committee disbursements must be made by check or similar drafts drawn on a designated campaign depository. 103.3(a). (Cash disbursements of \$100 or less per transaction may be made from a petty cash fund. 102.11.) The following institutions may be designated: state banks, national banks and depositories insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or the National Credit Union Administration. 103.1, 103.2 and 103.3(a).

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Again as mentioned above I have secured an account with a State Bank as expressed on the Form I document, stating name and address as depository. This is a checking account of my own accord. I have no Funding at this time to report as of date of this ?Freedom Committee? Statement of Organization Form I, as it is in incubus.

Please note: page 23, paragraph 5. Date Contribution Is Made -vs. Date of receipt -The date a contribution is made by the contributor and the date the contribution is received by the campaign are significant for purposes of the contribution limits. It is important to understand the distinction.

As treasurer I also have met as a Business: Paradyne Networks A Foundation, the requisite Statement of Trade Name with the Colorado Secretary of State. Please see Execution Form NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE, INC. AGREEMENT FOR RECEIPT AND USE OF CONSOLIDATED NETWORK A DATA AND NYSE MARKET DATA for further verification. One can find this document at URL: www.sos.state.co.us.

Also page 29 paragraph 12; when candidates use their personal funds for campaign purposes, they are making contributions to their campaigns. Unlike other contributions, these candidate contributions are not subject to any limits. 110.10; AOs 1991-09, 1990-09, 1985-33 and 1984-60.

Lastly and to reiterate I have sent the Statement of Organization to the Federal Election Committee and was given a Committee ID number, there are no other changes to be made; in this line 5d, I am a Republican, regardless of personal opinion of the distinctions of National Parties both Democratic and Republican the line designates a ?choice?, and I have voted as a republican.

I have also sent a signed document which represents I am the duly appointed Treasurer and I have the authority to sign FEC reports for this Freedom Committee. This was dated and signed July 29, 2013.

When contributions are submitted to this ?Freedom Committee? I will report it to the Federal Election Committee. This concludes the requests of information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances.
