
Dear Mr. Gibson:

This letter is in response to the Commission's inquiry of several contributions reported on the 30 Day Post-General Report (10/19/00-11/27/00). The inquiry stated that the contributions questioned appeared to be in excess of the allowed amounts for non-multicandidate political committees.

Mainstream PAC qualified as a multicandidate committee on September 19, 2000, and a notice was sent to the Federal Election Commission on September 20, 2000. A copy of the Notification of Multicandidate Status as well as the other documents sent at the same time are enclosed. The contributions about which you have inquired were made pursuant to the Multicandidate Committee status established by Mainstream PAC.
