Dear Mr. England:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

- Your report discloses a total of \$11,760.70 in prepayments from Federal candidates on Schedule A. However, it appears that there are only \$8,000.77 in payments for services on behalf of these candidates disclosed on Schedule B.

In response to an FEC inquiry, you state that this discrepancy is "reflected in payroll taxes payable to the Internal Revenue Service and Indiana Department of Revenue." Please amend Schedule B of your report to indicate each candidate's share of these taxes.

- Please clarify all expenditures made for "fundraising" on Schedule(s) B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B, E or F supporting Lines 23, 24 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1


- Schedule F of your report discloses the Aggregate General Election Expenditure(s) for Evan Bayh to be \$103,648.52. However, FEC calculations disclose this amount(s) to be \$108,107.13. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Transfers from affiliated committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule A, supporting Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions for each line when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing.

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
