This letter is in response to the FEC letters relating to certain FEC Reports by end of year (7/01/01 - 12/31/01) and mid-year (1/1/01 - 6/30/01). Both letters have to do with certain information relating to itemization of employee information.

No amended report is necessary as the two Reports in question are accurate and fully provide all aggregated contributions. In a letter to the FEC dated October 10, 2000 we addressed a similar problem in response to an FEC request regarding a Quarterly Report at that time.

The problem occurs because our Wells Fargo Human Resource Dept. identifies Wells Fargo employees by discrete Wells Fargo Business Units and not simply by Wells Fargo. But they are all Wells Fargo employees all contributing to the same Wells Fargo Employee PAC.

In phone calls placed during 2002 to the FEC, I spoke with and discussed our HR problem with staff such as Jane Parks who had signed one of the FEC letters. She was most helpful and understanding.

I regret not sending this letter to you earlier, but I can report that adjustments have been made so that for all future FEC filings our HR systems will report each contribution(s) as made by a Wells Fargo Employee in clearer detail.
