On June 10, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced reports raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your June 19, 1998 responses are incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For these responses to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The Commission acknowledges your letter dated June 19, 1998 and the attached correspondence originally dated July 30, 1997. You state that an outside auditing service was retained to clarify accounting errors on reports filed from 1993 to 1997 and would be used in the future to ensure proper disclosure of the PAC's activities. However, the information provided does not address any Reports that have been filed in 1998. You still need to provide clarification of the discrepancies in the beginning and ending cash on hand amounts reported on your 1998 February and March Monthly Reports.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
