This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following 3 item(s):

- 1. Schedule A supporting Line 16 discloses a refund of a contribution received from Friends of Madeleine Dean. However, it appears that this contribution was not previously reported by your committee. Please amend the appropriate reports(s) to disclose the original contribution or provide clarifying information. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. §434(b)) and 11 CFR § 104.3(a) & (b))
- 2. On Schedule B supporting Line 29, you have itemized disbursements for which you have failed to include the address. Please amend your report to include the missing information. (11 CFR § 104.3(b)(3))
- Your committee has filed a 48 independent 3. hour report for an expenditure supporting Rich Lazer (see attached) which has not been itemized on Schedule E supporting Line 24 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please be advised that independent expenditures disclosed on 48 hour reports must also be itemized on a corresponding Schedule E or MEMO Schedule E and Schedule D (if applicable), in the appropriate reporting period. Further, if the actual payment(s) for the independent expenditure(s) occurs after the date of dissemination, the appropriate report(s) should continue to show payment on Schedule E and Schedule D, until the debt is fully extinguished. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.
