
Dear Ms. Williamson:

As we have previously advised the Commission, the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee discloses its memo entries from its affiliated committees on a monthly reporting cycle and reports its transfers-in on Line 12 based upon the dates the dollars are actually received. Thus, a memo entry will be included in the Committee's report if dollars were contributed in that period to the affiliated committee. However, dollars from the affiliated committees are transferred only periodically to the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee; thus there is no direct relationship between the dollars on the monthly memo entries and the dollars reported as received on Line 12.

With respect to the Schedule A supporting Line 28(c), the contribution was made through the Illinois Senate 2002 Committee, a joint fundraising committee with the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee. Enclosed is a copy of the Illinois Senate 2002, 11c attributable, reflecting the Enron contribution which was include in our November Monthly Report (10/1/01-10/31/01).
