Re: Committee's response to FEC RQ-2 (FEC Request for Additional Information)

Ms. Liljeroot:

In response to your Request for Additional Information, the Committee has taken the following corrective action:

I. The Committee has filed Amended Pre-Primary and April Quarterly Reports to correct Column B and Beginning Cash Balance discrepancies referenced in your request.

II. Regarding the omission of 48 Hour Notices referenced, the Committee has discovered the following: 1. Due to a data entry error and/or technical error on the Committee's part, contributions for Daphne G. Moss, Ricky Raven and Mary Redmond were omitted from the Committee's 48 Hour Notice filing number 24990682434. The Committee has complied by reporting such contributions in its April Quarterly report and subsequent amendments. 2. The Committee received the contribution of Johnny Lee Tates on 03/08/04, a date after the expiration of the 48 Hour Notice Period (02/19/04 - 03/06/04). Accordingly, the Committee reported such contribution in its April Quarterly report. 3. Due to an oversight on the Committee's part, contributions of Clay Jr. for Congress, David Harris and Sam Munroe Jr. were not included in its 48 Hour Notice filing. The Committee has complied by reporting such contributions in its April Quarterly report and all subsequent amendments thereto.

III. In response to your request that the Committee amend its report and include Contributor information not included in its April Quarterly report and provide a detailed description of procedures for obtaining the information, the Committee has complied by doing the following:

1. The Committee has amended its April Quarterly Report to include the required information that was omitted at the time of submission.

2. To request the contributor information that the Committee was not in receipt of at the time of its April Quarterly report submission and/or not included from its April Quarterly report, the Committee: (a) sent a formal solicitation for the information, such solicitation was in compliance with 11 CFR Sec. 104.7(b)(1). The Committee documented the date and manner of receipt of the requested information. In the the event that the Committee had not received a responses within 15 days of its initial solicitation, the Committee: (b) made an additional follow-up request. Follow-up requests were made in writing or by phone pursuant to 11 CFR Sec. 104.7(b)(2). The Committee, at all times, has maintained copies of the initial and follow-up solicitation letters and documented dates, times and outcomes of follow-up telephone calls. All solicitation efforts were made within the time requirements of 11 CFR Sec. 104.7(b)(2).

3. Despite its use of the three-fold 'best efforts' process within the manner and time limits as established by the Campaign Finance Laws, (the Committee's best efforts are detailed above and documented in the Committee's records), the Committee has been unable to obtain the required employer and occupation of some contributors. Additional follow-up requests have been made to obtain this information and will be submitted upon receipt.

IV. Omitted Addresses From Schedule B: In response to your request that the Committee amend its pre-primary report to include addresses, the Committee has amended its April Quarterly Report accordingly.
