Your November 19, 2002 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Please clarify all expenditures made for "ADVERTISING/DINGLE OF MI" on Schedule(s) B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on either Schedules B, E, or F supporting Lines 23, 24 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate in an electronic format. In your letter dated October 15, 2002, you noted problems with electronically filing Schedules E because of the software you or your vendor is using. The FEC's software, FECFile, Version 4 can be downloaded, free of charge, from the FEC web site at <http://www.fec.gov>. Please amend your report electronically to disclose the expenditure on the correct type of schedule. 11 CFR §§104.2(b) and 106.1

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by December 25, 2002. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions

of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
