Additional information on three contributions itemized on the July 15 report and reported via 48-hour notices. 1) United Transportation Union (UTU) which we reported as a contribution of \$1,000 via 48-hour notice on 5/14/04 is the same PAC as Transportation Political Education League which was reported as a contribution of \$1,000 dated 5/14/04 on Schedule A. They have changed their name with the FEC. 2) A \$1,000 contribution from Steven Caplan was reported via 48-hour notice on 5/7/04 and is itemized on Schedule A. This contribution is divided into \$500 for the general election and \$500 for the primary election, both dated 5/7/04 on Schedule A. 3) The \$1,000 contribution itemized on Schedule A from Amy Kuo was inadvertently reported as a \$1,000 contribution from her spouse, Patrick Chen, via 48-hour notice. In order to report receipt of the check to the FEC in a timely manner, knowledge of the check was conveyed by an agent of the campaign to the finance office via telephone. It was not determine until receipt of the check by the finance office that the check was drawn on an account held solely by Amy Kuo and not jointly with Patrick Chen. We have reviewed and made changes to the procedures used to report pre-election contributions received by agents of the campaign.
