Your March 26, 2001, responses are incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For these responses to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Your response has provided the name of the office sought for contributions on Schedule B supporting Line 23; however, you still need to provide the state and congressional district, if applicable for each contribution made. 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(ii) and (v)

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by April 25, 2001. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
