This responds to your letter dated March 3, 2019 regarding the 30-day post-general election campaign report filed by California Real Estate Political Action Committee/Federal? California Association of REALTORS (the ?Committee?) for the period October 18, 2018 to November 26, 2018. You requested clarifying information concerning a Late 24-Hour Report (Schedule E) the Committee filed disclosing an independent expenditure opposing congressional candidate Mimi Walters, which was publicly disseminated on October 25, 2018.

Consistent with the requirements of 11 CFR ? 104.4(c), the Committee prepared and transmitted a report electronically to the Commission disclosing this expenditure on October 26, 2018 at 10:13 p.m. EST, which is reflected in the date the report was electronically signed by the Committee?s Treasurer and the Committee?s electronic filing records.

In the event a report is rejected, a political committee typically receives via email a notice of rejection from the Commission immediately after a report is filed. This allows a committee to timely correct or refile a campaign report.

When the Committee transmitted this report for filing, however, it did not receive a notice of rejection from the Commission at the time of its transmission. The Committee?s electronic filing vendor has confirmed that the report was not rejected by the Commission at the time of its submission on October 26. Three days after the Committee submitted this report for filing, it received a notice from the Commission acknowledging its receipt. The electronic filing platform used by the Committee, known as Netfile, assigns a unique document identification number for each report prepared by the Committee. A review of the Committee?s electronic filing records demonstrates that the report acknowledged by the Commission has the exact document identification number as the report transmitted by the Committee on October 26.

Accordingly, we believe the Committee complied with the requirements of 11 CFR ? 104.4(c) by submitting the report for filing on October 26 at 10:13 p.m. EST, within 24 hours of the independent expenditure?s public dissemination.

We hope this sufficiently addresses your request for additional information.
