On November 10, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your November 24, 1998 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-You have indicated that staffers received one check on 9/30/98 for the month of September which was pro-rated between the number of days that fell before the Primary election and the number of days that fell after the Primary election. It appears that you have only itemized that portion of each employees salary which was designated to the Primary election. You should amend Schedule B to include the remainder of the amount paid for the month of September which should be designated to the General election. You should also clarify if these employees were employed for the entire month of September or only until the date of the Primary election for the campaign they were involved with.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
