

I want to thank the hundreds of Shareholders' who attended the annual meeting on May 21, for your attendance, your comments and your recommendations at the meeting. For those of you who did not attend, we all hope that you will participate in the future, but in the mean time, please do not forget to do your business at IBC and recommend your friends and business associates to IBC.

Dear (Board Member):

# INTERNATIONAL BANK OF COMMERCE COMMITTEE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND BETTERMENT OF THE COUNTRY IBC/IBC PAC

The reason for giving to a political action committee (PAC) representing the industry in which we work is simple and compelling: access to decision makers adds significantly to the ability to get our point across.

Legislators don't just legislate--they are politicians who campaign and campaigns are expensive. Thus, it is the organizations who participate and understand the balance between the legislative and political processes who must call on their members to fund campaigns.

Listed below are answers to questions often asked about IBC/IBC PAC.

## Q. What is the purpose of IBC/IBC PAC?

A. IBC/IBC-PAC is a political action committee organized to collect funds and provide contributions to Federal, State and Local candidates who are supportive of our issues.

PAC is operated in accordance with applicable Federal and Texas Law.

## Q. Who can contribute to IBC/IBC PAC?

A. Officers, employees and directors of IBC are the primary source of contributions. Partnerships, professional corporations and professional associations can contribute, but corporate contributions are not acceptable.

Another source of contributions is an out-of-state federal PAC, such as a PAC of a member plant's corporate parent. Again, corporate funds cannot flow through these committees to IBC/IBC PAC. Contributions from this source must have documentation as required by law.

## Q. Are there limits on contributions to the IBC/IBC PAC?

A. No limits is established by Texas law.

Federal contributions are limited to \$5,000 per calendar year per candidate.

IBC/IBC-PAC will report contributions of \$25 or more individually with the name, address, and occupation of the contributor. If a partnership, professional corporation or professional association reimburses contributions, the reimbursing entity is listed as the ultimate contributor on our reports.

## Q. How are funds that are contributed to IBC/IBC PAC used?

A. All IBC/IBC-PAC funds go to candidates. IBC/IBC-PAC's Board of Directors targets candidates and establishes priorities for contributions based on information provided by IBC/IBC PAC Board.

IBC/IBC PAC is non-partisan and supports both Republicans and Democrats.

## Q. How is IBC/IBC-PAC operated?

A. Administrative costs are provided by IBC/IBC PAC Board is the PAC treasurer and files all reports required by the state.

## Q. How do I solicit contributions for the PAC?

A. Contributions to the IBC/IBC-PAC are voluntary.

IBC/IBC-PAC should be explained to the potential contributor. In addition, it should be clear that no job discrimination or financial reprisal will be taken against any employee or contractor.

## Q. How do I start?

A. Use the tear-off portion of this brochure to initiate your contribution.
