Dear Mr. Angle:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$463,291 in itemized contributions from individuals. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$458,792. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy. Please be advised that Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) does not include page 119.

-Your report discloses receipts totalling \$20,000 from the Democratic Leaders Victory Fund 1998, which is a joint fundraising committee(s) affiliated with your committee. Please be advised that a memo Schedule A must be provided to itemize your committee's share of the gross contributions received through the joint fundraiser(s). The memo schedule should itemize each individual who has contributed an aggregate in excess of \$200 during the calendar year, and provide the amount of unitemized contributions received. In addition, the memo schedule should itemize your committee's share of all contributions from political committees, regardless of amount. 11 CFR §102.17(c)(8)(i)(B)

-Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$8,506 in transfers from Civil Justice For America, which is a joint fundraising committee affiliated with your committee. The sum of the entries itemized on memo Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$500. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$4,708 in transfers from Philadelphia Victory 97, which is a joint fundraising committee affiliated with your committee. The sum of the entries itemized on memo Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$500. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
